Slippery Rock Tournaments- Rules

Tournament Format

- These tournaments are showcase format, with preset schedules. These
 designed to allow you to showcase your players at the best of the teams
 ability.
- Teams competing in tournaments will be subject to a 7-inning or 2 hour time limit.
- All games will be played under High School Rules.
- Run Rules: 15 runs after 3 innings of play- 10 runs after 4 innings of play.
- All games will be played on 90 feet bases.
- Teams should be ready to play 15 minutes before the scheduled game is set to begin.
- Games completed early will result in the following game starting early.
- Please advise players to warm-up in outfield, not in front of dugouts.
- Infield and Outfield will be permitted when time allows, this is a decision made by tournament Director on a game-to-game basis.
- Cages will be open to use before games in left and right field bullpens when previous game starts.
- There will be 15 minutes period between games to allow for dragging of field
- Teams will be allowed to use a DH and or a EH.
- High School Baseball will apply
- Players are allowed to reenter at will.
- Age Restriction- A player's age on May 1 is his/her age for the entire year. Graduations years set each player's actual age for all tournaments. 2014 grads are 18 regardless of birth date, 2015 are 17, etc.
- Courtesy Runner- Must be used for catcher/pitcher with 2 outs, Optional with less than 2 outs.
- Intentional Walk- Automatic internal walks will be issued.
- Tie Games- Games reaching the 8th inning of play will go into hurry game mode, with a runner starting on 2nd base.
- All players must use BBCOR certified bats or Wood.
- Select tournaments are wood bat only

Weather & Game Delays

- Rain can come into play in any tournament. We will do everything possible to play games
- Games will be complete with a 4 ½ innings of play
- The score of the game will be frozen and picked up where left off should play be suspended for any reason.
- We will try our best to stick to the set schedule if rain occurs
- Weather plays a factor in any outdoor sporting event. We will do everything possible to get all games in without risking the safety of anyone involved.

Should weather play a part in cancellation of any event, below are Slippery Rock Tournaments Refund Policy

Refund Policy

- Should weather cause an event to be completely cancelled having played no games all teams will receive a full entrance fee credit toward a future event-taking place within a full calendar year.
- Should an event be canceled for any reason other than weather, prior to the tournament, teams will receive a full refund.
- Should just one game be played before an event is cancelled, due to weather, a credit will be issued for 50% of fee toward a future tournament.
- There will be no refunds or credits after the start of each teams second game.
- Teams having completed registration are fully expected to attend event. No refunds or credit will be given to teams that withdraw.
- Please remind your fans and players to respect these policies in place at field. If ejected from an event (player, coach, or fan) is ejected for remainder of the game and subjected to ejection for the remainder of tournament at tournament Directors discretion.
